Institutional and Overhead Costs Policy

Policy Title: Use of Funds – Institutional/Overhead Restriction

Organization: Association of Hemostasis Clinic Doctors of Canada (AHCDC)

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to establish AHCDC's requirements regarding the use of grant and award funds for institutional overhead, indirect costs, and core operating expenses.

Policy Statement:

Funds awarded by AHCDC are intended to directly support the activities, projects, and initiatives for which the funding has been approved.

Grant funds may not be used to support institutional overhead or core operating costs. Accordingly, institutions are expected to waive any indirect or overhead fees associated with the award.

Application:

This policy applies to AHCDC grant and award funding provided to recipients and their respective institutions.

Recipients and administering institutions are responsible for ensuring that AHCDC funds are used in accordance with this restriction and are not allocated toward institutional overhead, indirect costs, or core operating expenses.

Institutional Requirements:

Institutions administering an AHCDC grant or award are expected to accept the funding without applying institutional overhead or indirect fees to the awarded amount.
